- Relationships with the community

The presentations were all based on large, well-established markets from cities and towns which were very different from Wem. However, some interesting ideas were gained including:

- Cirencester occasional health & wellbeing events run with the NHS
- Harborough events which draw people to the market are usually not moneymakers, but raise the market's profile
- Harborough vegetable coupons have been used to assist low-income households
- Generally there is a need to encourage younger people to become market traders
