Marshalling of the parade and management of road closures

The Clerk reported that the road closure had been applied for and signs would go up the week before half term.

The parade to the church will leave at 10.45 not 10.50 as stated on the documentation.

A walkthrough will take place the week before the parade with John Jukes and representatives from Wem Band, RBL, Wem Cadets and the Town Council.

Wreath laying ceremony including reading of names
